Iowa's Hidden Treasures Presented by Dan Kaercher, Wednesday, January 7, 7:00 PM

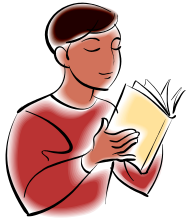
