Fair Trade Artisan Women in Developing Countries

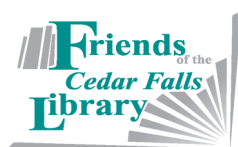

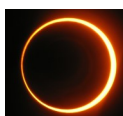
